#### **CompAir with Aston University**


The origins of CompAir can be traced back to two British companies, Holman and BroomWade, with over 200 years of experience.

"In the early 1970's industry was becoming more energy conscious and [the business] realised it needed a more efficient product ... and so the V-Compact was born.

It comprised four basic machines from 100 to 300 cfm which were high speed, two stage air-cooled compressors with a high degree of component interchangeability to which oil free and single stage variants were added later. Many thousands of these compressors have been built and sold all over the world.

By 1975 the CompAir Group was the largest manufacturer of air compressors and pneumatic equipment in the UK. The group employed more than 8,000 people, ran seven manufacturing locations in the UK. World sales for 1975 totalled £86m, with pre-tax profit of £7.3m"

The business is still trading and is now owned by Ingersoll Rand.

### Platts was established in 1967 and back then we provided traditional spray paint services to agricultural and commercial vehicle customers.

We like to think the growth in the years that followed came for two reasons. One, from our ability to handle plant, vehicles and components that were too large for regular paint-shops, and two, from our willingness to innovate, expand our knowledge and develop our skills.







### Where it all began

- We believe that Professor Derek Saunders started TCS
- He studied physics at Imperial College during the war years
- After graduating in 1945 he pursued his interest in the emerging field of Polymer Physics eventually heading the Department of Materials at the (then) Cranfield Institute of Technology.
- His over-arching ambition to bring together research and industry lead to him serving as Director of the Teaching Company Scheme until his retirement in 1988.

### **Impact of KTP**

- KTP has supported over 14,000 projects since 1975.
- Approximately 11,000 of these have been with SMEs.
- From 2010 to 2020, Innovate UK invested £200m in 2,000 projects, adding £2.3bn to the economy.
- KTP continues to fund over 300 new partnerships each year, with innovative businesses across the UK



  - We will seek other funding to allow us to continue delivery










#### Transition to new database
